



House rules

Check in time is from 4 pm.

Check out time is at 11 pm

Opening hours are from 8:30 am to 10 pm

Breakfast hours are from 8:30 am to 10 am

Dinner time: 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm; The **kitchen closes** at 9:30 pm in summer and at 9 pm the rest of the year.

Guided tours of the house for our guests will take place on **Friday afternoons**.

Please, when you enter the valley, enjoy the beautiful views and **drive slowly**, there are **wild animals** that can cross it; therefore, be attentive and delight in the possibility of seeing wild and domestic fauna in this area.

When you arrive at the property, please also drive carefully, and watch the road, especially if it has rained, since **amphibians** can cross it and their ability to escape is very reduced and slow. There may also be some cat loose, so please take precautions.

Upon arrival, you can drive to the landhouse's entrance, park momentarily under the fig tree to unload and then take the car to the parking area that you will see signposted along the way.

We have the "**like at home**" service, where you can serve yourself drinks from the guest refrigerator and write down the drinks on the blackboard, in the space with the name of your room. This service is only for adults. We will confirm times for this service upon arrival.

The kitchen and living room on the ground floor is where **breakfast** and **dinner** are served exclusively. These spaces will have their doors closing time at 11 p.m. as well as the "like at home" service. Therefore, the outdoor areas will be available and (if not reserved) the P1 lounge will also be available, to end the evening, if you feel like staying up late quietly like owls.



Smoking is not allowed inside the farmhouse, except on terraces, balconies and outdoor areas. Always away from children and other non-smoking adults. Please place cigarette butts in the ashtrays available.

Our **toilets are SEPARATIVE**, so yellow water should not be mixed with black water. We ask that **you always sit down, including the men**, to relieve yourself since otherwise it is impossible to ensure this separation in our differentiated treatment systems.

Please bring footwear for exclusive use inside the landhouse, to keep it free of dirt and mud. You can leave your outdoor shoes in the shoe rack at reception.

In summer, we ask that you do not enter the farmhouse wet, nor sit on both outdoor and indoor sofas, with swimsuits or wet clothes.

The consumption of food or drinks from outside is not permitted in any area of Mas Campassol.

Each living room has a fireplace with wood from the forest.

We have separate recycling containers.

Acoustic respect

Naturally we appreciate respect for the rest of all guests, with silence after 11pm.

Please do not use speakers anywhere outside the farmhouse.

The music of the environment is the singing of birds and the rustling of trees and nature, which we understand is what we all know how to appreciate in such a wonderful place.

Pool



Hours: from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Pool with a **maximum depth of 1.50m**. For safety reasons, jumping headfirst is prohibited. The pool is fenced and without lifeguard supervision. Minors must always be accompanied by an adult to the pool area.

There is one pool towel allocated per person, placed in the room upon arrival. For changes, please contact our team. Pool towels must be hand delivered during check out. Please make responsible use of resources.

It is mandatory to shower before entering the water.

Balls or bulky inflatables are not allowed, for the comfort of other guests.

Our pool has a **hydrolysis** purification system that prevents irritation of our skin, as well as chlorine poisoning of animals that may use it as a watering hole.

We regret having to ask that you put a leash on the animals that accompany you here, (in the river 8 minutes from the house, you can bathe together :-)

The use of our **Balinese bed** is allowed as long as it has not been reserved by a guest. We offer to **privatize** this daybed at any time, consult our team or in the services section of our website.

The access doors to the pool must be closed, please open and close them each time you pass.

Eating is not allowed in the pool area, nor is the use of glass bottles or glasses; We have green hard plastic glasses and cups, safer and more suitable for the pool area.

Akira's club



The children's area hours are 9am. until dark; Closing time will depend on the time of year.

Akira's club is an unsupervised children's area, with structures and games for children of various ages. Children must always be accompanied by adults.

Smoking is only allowed in the area furthest from the pool or on the terrace area, for obvious reasons, it is prohibited in *Akira's club*.

Our furry companions cannot be loose in this area, for the safety of the little ones.

The access doors to the children's area must be closed after passing through the entrance or exit.

Its doors, as well as in the pool area, will always be closed at dusk to prevent the passage of fauna.

We invite you to **tour** the 43ha of the estate along **paths of different intensity**, some suitable for all ages, without leaving Mas Campassol.

Let's explain to our sons and daughters that nature must be taken care of and preserved, respecting the fauna and flora. For example, avoiding stepping on moss areas, especially in the Atlantic flora part of the forest. Of course, keeping the natural spaces that we visit clean, and not modifying the environment, avoiding actions such as picking flowers, mushrooms, insects or other living materials, important for other beings and the ecosystem.

On excursions we recommend wearing mountain footwear and **not leaving the established routes**.

For smokers we have portable ashtrays at your disposal.

We appreciate that you bring back any waste that may be generated during the excursion, so that we can recycle it.

Keep your eyes wide open to identify the different traces that you will find in your path, left by the wildlife with which we coexist in Mas Campassol. We're free of hunting and the suffering inherent to this practice, so pleased to host many of the species in the area, which we follow using photo trapping cameras that we place in different areas of the area. That is why we know that fauna abounds; finding traces increases the possibility of seeing it, which you can decipher with the help of our guides :)

Naturally, **dogs** are always **welcome**, taking into account that the responsibility will be that of the adult caregivers in their charge.

We appreciate that, at the time of your stay with us, your furry friend has up-to-date vaccinations and pertinent deworming, thus guaranteeing a healthy coexistence with the environment and its inhabitants. Please bring your card up to date.

If your dog has any behavioral peculiarities, such as phobias or socialization problems, etc., please let us know, in case there is anything we can help with so you can have a pleasant stay.

We appreciate you bringing your beds, food containers, water and a doggie towel, so they will feel at home.

Before entering the farmhouse, we ask that you clean their paws with a towel that you must have available.

Dogs can accompany them on a leash inside the farmhouse, and enter the living room area for breakfast, but avoiding the kitchen area.

We understand that they are used to sleeping on the couch or bed in their homes, but we ask that you instead bring their beds and blankets from home so that they are comfortable, as well as toys so that they can feel at home.

It is not allowed to leave animals alone in the rooms or any other space on the property, they must always be accompanied.

Any damage caused by our furry family must be compensated.

In the threshing floor, we have a fountain on the wall, with an open bar of water for the furry friends.

In the rainy season, it is important that you also bring a towel for doggie use, to dry the furry body and its paws before entering the farmhouse. If you are a naughty furry and get into the mud, let us know and we can help you with a space for bathing and hygiene before entering.

They must be tied in shared areas, and with more care around the pool and children's area, as well as in garden spaces, which they cannot step on.

It is very important that, inside the farmhouse and in the surrounding area, they are tied and controlled to avoid accidents with other bipedal or quadruped guests. And also in this way avoid incidents with the inhabitants of the shelter, being rescued animals, to whom we do not want to generate more stress than they have already suffered.

During visits to the shelter facilities, your companion can wait for you tied up, cooling off with a bowl of water and a good shade or sun, depending on the temperature.

We will appreciate it if you walk them on a leash and accompany them to relieve themselves away from the house. Please bury the excrement, to protect the environment for other guests and residents. Avoid collecting them in plastic bags, so as not to generate unnecessary waste.

They can go off leash only on forest paths, away from the house. Always plan to wear a leash, in case you encounter wildlife during the walk. We will indicate the best routes for this.

If you are going to walk through the valley, always take them on a leash until you reach mountain roads, as a precaution against hunting instincts arising, with the domestic animals of the neighboring farms, which are many... and because of the cars from neighbors and visitors.
